Examples of Activities That Constitute Distinguished Service to AILA

Distinguished service is defined as contributions that go beyond routine committee membership or participation. The following activities exemplify distinguished service

- **Long-term Impactful Committee Leadership** – Serving for 10+ years on committees, leading initiatives, and successfully launching documents that benefit AILA and the profession.
- **Policy & Advocacy Contributions** – Driving key policy changes that influence the profession and government regulations.
- **Mentorship & Education** – Establishing mentorship programs, leading workshops, or shaping education programs that develop future landscape architects.
- **Strategic Development of AILA** – Contributing to national growth strategies, membership expansion, or financial sustainability.
- **Major Event Leadership** – Organizing and delivering national conferences, symposia, or initiatives that elevate AILA’s profile.
- **Recognition & Awards Leadership** – Creating award programs that celebrate and encourage excellence in landscape architecture.
- **Cross-Industry Collaboration** – Representing AILA in significant interdisciplinary forums, contributing to broader industry developments.
- **Innovative Contributions** – Pioneering new methodologies, research, or projects that enhance the standing of landscape architecture in Australia.
